1 pm Travel the 7 miles over to Victor where you can enjoy:
Lowell Thomas Museum (719-689-5509)
Ag and Mining History Museum
Walking tour in Historic Victor

3:30 pm Return to Cripple Creek and Ride the Cripple Creek/Victor Narrow Gauge Railroad
