Two nights: **Albuquerque**—Rio Grande Pueblos—**Taos**—Taos Pueblo—Rio Grande Gorge—Pagosa Hot Springs—**Durango**—Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Train—**Albuquerque**

Three nights: **Albuquerque**—Coronado State Monument—Chaco Culture National Historical Park—**Farmington, NM**—Mesa Verde National Park—**Cortez**—Canyon de Chelly National Monument—Hubbell Trading Post—**Gallup**—Zuni Pueblo—El Morro National Monument—**ABQ**
