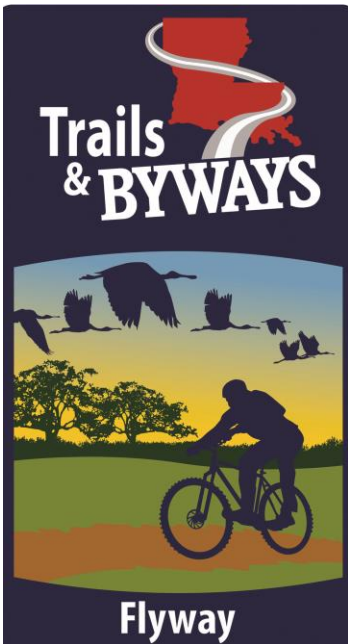




come **CLOSER** *to the Flyway Byway*



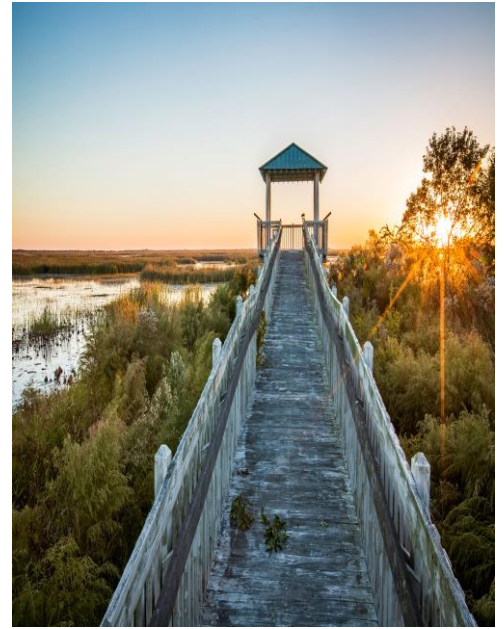
Explore the Flyway Byway, a scenic trail through swamp, river, farmland and unique landscape that is part of the Louisiana Trails and Byways program. The 55-mile driving trail takes visitors on a scenic loop throughout Jefferson Davis Parish, home to more than 160 species of birds, making it a paradise for birders! Take Exit 54 on I-10 in Welsh, La. Go south on La. Hwy.99 to La. Hwy.14 and loop Lake Arthur. Then travel north on La. Hwy 26 through Jennings to I-10. Take Exit 64, or return west on U.S. Hwy.90- the historic Old Spanish Trail- to Welsh.

What is there to do on the Flyway Byway? Drive for pleasure. See the countryside. Watch birds and wildlife. Experience nature and wildlife in its truest form. Canoe or kayak the waterways. Shop in small towns. Eat local food. Enjoy area hospitality. Relax and unwind in area hotels. Learn about area agriculture and industry. Experience unique festivals and events.



NOT-TO-BE-MISSED EXPERIENCES

- **Gator Chateau**: Hold a baby gator! Rescue, Educate, Release facility where visitors can hold and take their picture with a baby alligator!
- **LA Oil & Gas Park**: Visitor info, fishing pond, playground area, walking track
- **Lacassine National Wildlife Refuge**: observation pier, fishing, hiking and biking trails, boating, birding
- **Lorrain Bridge and Park**: Historic wooden bridge perfect for photographers. Outdoor pavilions, camp sites, boat launch and picnic tables
- **Zigler Art Museum**: Collections spanning four centuries by well-known masters and Louisiana artists.
- **Historic Strand Theatre**: Art deco movie theatre, circa 1939. Home to local theatre group.
- **W. H. Tupper General Merchandise Museum**: Step back in time over 50 years with a visit to an authentic country store.
- **Welsh Museum**: Hundreds of old photographs, schoolhouse items, farm equipment, and other town memorabilia.
- **Bayou Rum Distillery**: Tour and see how Bayou Rum is made, with all Louisiana ingredients. Visit their in-house tasting bar, gift shop and visitors center.
- **Crawfish Farm Tour**: Tour a working crawfish farm with a local farmer, then visit a local crawfish co-op. (seasonal March-May)
