Boating along the Intracoastal Waterways are popular destinations for our locals and visitors.

Safety is always our number one priority for the boaters and the wildlife that inhabits our area. Please pay attention to your surroundings, channel markers and no wake zones. Having a boating plan before heading out and checking all safety equipment is important.

Heading out to our beaches, we encourage you to swim in areas patrolled by lifeguards and pay attention to posted conditions. Rip currents may be present.

- Observe posted speed limits
- Watch for pedestrians and cyclists crossing
- Avoid distracted driving by pulling over to check directions or location

- Wear bright colors
