Explore the **International Selkirk Loop**, **North America's only International Scenic Byway**, located in Northern Idaho, Eastern Washington and Southeastern British Columbia. Tour the oldest intact **paddlewheel ferry - SS Moyie**, visit the **ghost town** of Sandon and the Nikkei Internment Centre. Then hike **Idaho Peak** for possibly the **best view of the Selkirks**.

Visit Nelson, BC and see the **No. 1 small arts town in Canada**. This eclectic community is packed with fine dining, local shops, small art galleries and impromptu theatre venues. Catch a ride on **Streetcar 23**.

Tour **Gardner Cave**, or Box Canyon Dam and Boundary Dam. Watch **eagles** fish in the river or paddle a canoe along the water trail. Peddle on the **Lions Club railroad bike** and see amazing scenery that you can't see from the road.

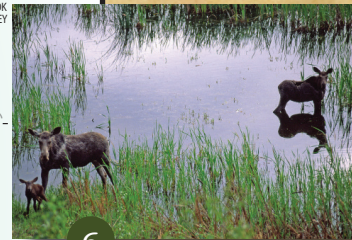
Visit the heart of the Selkirk's and **Idaho's Crown Jewel** - Priest Lake. This pristine area is the perfect place to enjoy the outdoors. Rent a boat and explore (or camp) on an **island**, hike to a waterfall, go fishing or just enjoy the spectacular view.

Visit the wineries and orchards in the Creston Valley. Tour the **Glass House** and see amazingly talented artisans along the east shore. Take the **ferry** across Kootenay Lake (*longest free ferry in the world*). Soak in the hot springs at **Ainsworth**.

Stop at the **friendliest small town in Idaho** - Bonners Ferry, as well as the nearby **Kootenai National Wildlife Refuge**. There is a 4.5 mile tour loop road for automobiles and foot trails that provide excellent viewing points for wildlife.

Spend the day in Sandpoint. Ride the chair lift, or zip-line at **Schweitzer**. Relax at City Beach, unique shopping and great dining await you. See why **USA Today** declared Sandpoint **"The Most Beautiful Small Town"**.
